Risk of falling! Always install guard railings!



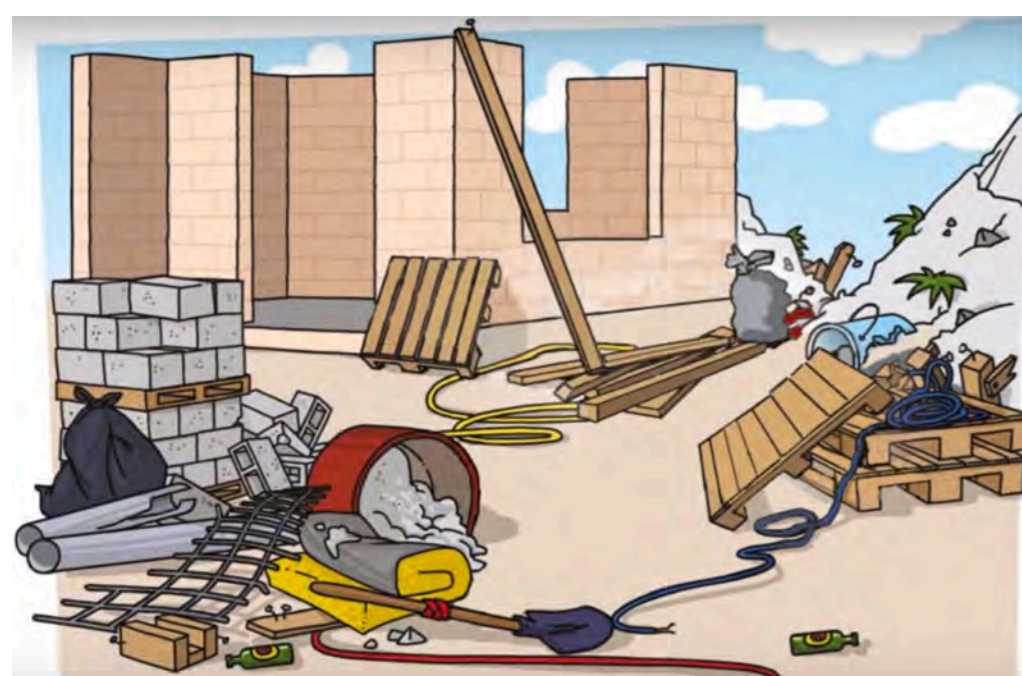
General information

- Keep the Construction site as clean and tidy as possible.

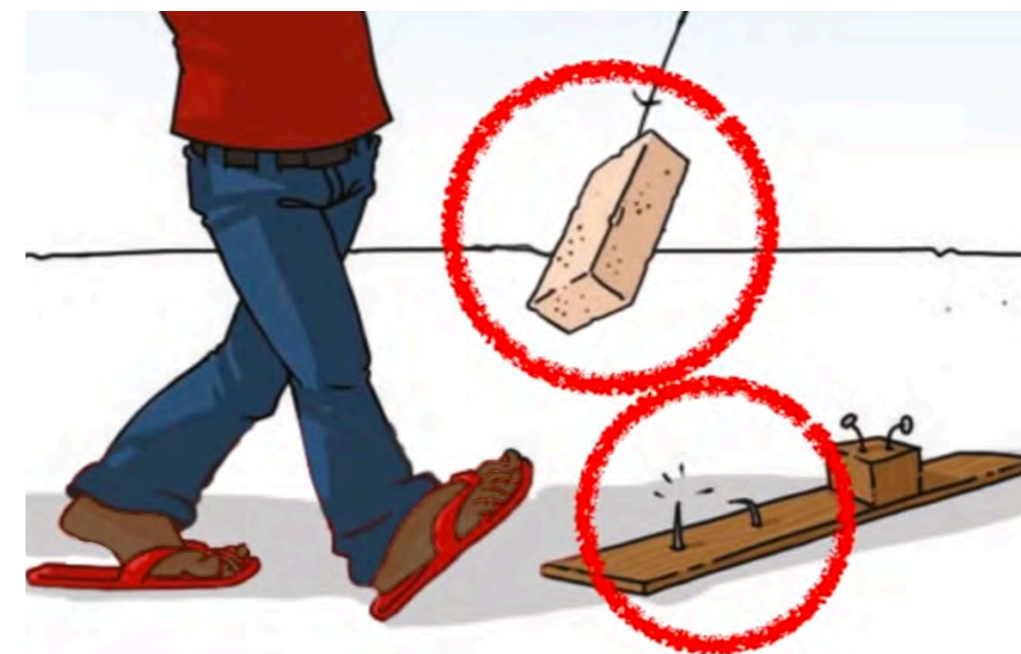
Tools

- Only use tools which are fully functional
- Damaged tools should be repaired as soon as possible

Electrical tools have to be fully functional. Make sure that electrical power supply is well installed and fused to avoid accidents and fires.

Protect yourself and wear Safety Shoes with toecaps and protective soles!



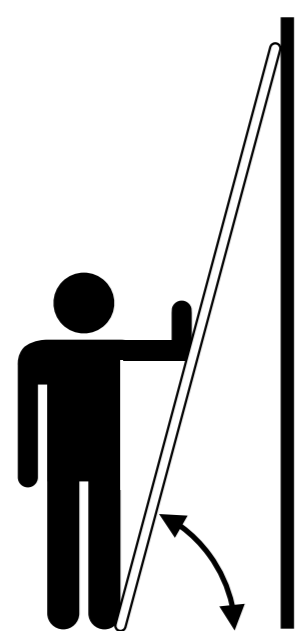
Hazards from falling items and low corners! Wear your helmet!



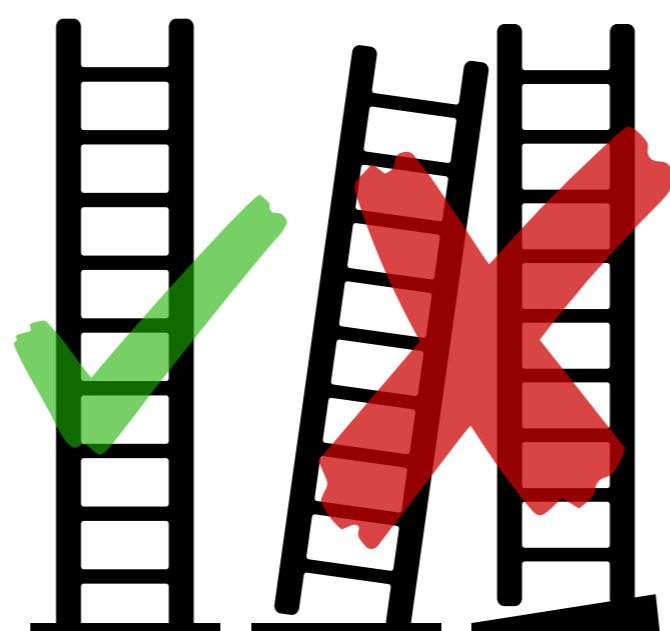
Ear protections sustain your hearing ability



Gloves prevent injuries



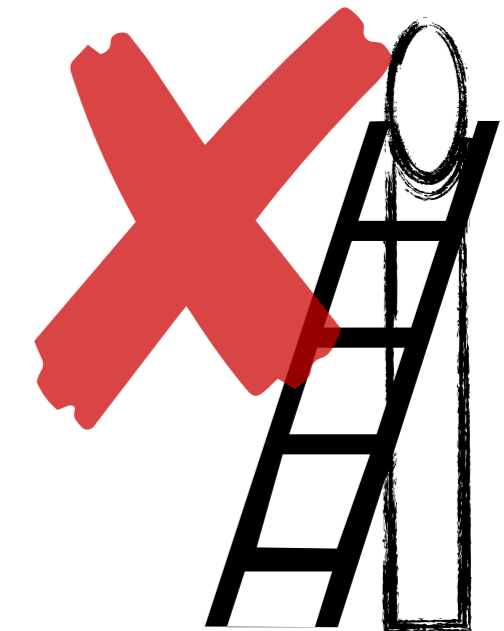
Set ladders on a proper angle of 65-75°
