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Professional training program offer

Certificate of Competence for carpentry instructors (MIC)

Duration: 8 weeks (320 hrs.) from August 2022 - March 2023

Location: Rubengera Technical Campus (RTC)

Registration: until 10.08.2022

Training program description

This professional training program for carpenters and carpentry trainers is an international certified program including an international assessment. It aims to qualify the participants as professional instructors in carpentry. The participants will receive a certificate of competence (national education partners) as well as a certificate as Master Instructor in Carpentry (international education partners). Training participants will be able to learn and practice instruction methodology for carpentry within their training group as a cross cutting competence in all training modules. Application and revision of technical module content (RTQF level 3-7) within typical carpentry working processes will support the competence acquisition of participants and prepare them for the final assessment. Trainees will be provided with access to e-learning content to revise and deepen their knowledge in wood- technology during the training period. The final assessment workshop includes for each participant briefing and preparation. The program will start on 15.08.2022 (1 week) with the basic module: carpentry tooling and machinery module including assessment. The number of participants is limited to 15.

Final competence assessment

The program competence assessment consists of 5 parts:

1= Planning Competence [5h]; 2= Practice Competence [8h]; 3= Theoretical Competence [3h];

4= Instructors Competence [2h]; 5= Evaluation Competence [1h]

The assessment committee consists of an international team of technicians and experts from the partnering institutions with a professional background in applied pedagogy, joinery and carpentry. Program assessment admission requirement: All modules of the MIC program (see program shedule above) have been successfully completed.

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Training program admission requirements (to be proved by the applicant with respective documents during registration)

1. Secondary school degree in carpentry/joinery and 2 years of working experience in the professional field of carpentry/joinery or at least the evidence of 5 years of experience in the professional field of carpentry/joinery or carpentry/joinery training
2. Proficient experience working with woodworking tools and machinery
3. Basic ICT Skills , MS office and provision of an ICT working place
4. Written and spoken competence in English language
5. Successful performance in the carpentry tooling and machinery module (basic module)
6. CAD drawing competence is an advantage but not a mandatory competence

Training program costs

The overall training costs including the provision of competent national and international trainers, training facilities as well as catering and accommodation for all participants during the training at the training facilities in Rubengera will be covered by the proWOOD program. Applicants are supposed to pay a registration fee of 10.000 RWF to confirm their registration for the training program participation. A second fee of 10.000RWF is required to be admitted to the final international assessment.

Training program provision & accreditation

The training is organized by ProWOOD. ProWOOD is a Partner Africa Project between the Internationaler Bund e.V. (IB) supported by the German Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development via Sequa (Germany). ProWOOD has been established to improve together with its partners training and promotion of the wood sector in Rwanda, especially in the western province. The Rwanda Wood Value Chain Association, IPRC Kitabi and Rubengera TVET are partners in the implementation of training activities. International accreditation partners from Germany for the training program are the Federal Training Center for Carpentry BuBiZa and Company FingerHaus GmbH.
